A Transfer Station is NOT the same as a Dump. This setup is to bring trucks in and dump it and is inside a building and then it is put into a bigger transfer truck to haul away to the dump.

The City of Statham has not issued any permits or will not issue any per-


mits to build a transfer station. It will wind up in court, and the covenants on the Industrial Park will prohibit that type of business.
