#### **OUTSIDE BURN BAN SCHEDULED TO BE LIFTED OCTOBER 1ST**

~ YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR FIRE, AND ITS SMOKE ~

All outdoor burning must have a permit and is good only for natural vegetative materials. It is unlawful to burn man made materials such as tires, shingles, plastics, lumber, household garbage, etc.

Burning Permits Are Good Only For The Day They Were Issued. If you obtain your permit after dark, your permit will be good for the following day.

You can obtain a burning permit by calling 1-877-OK2-BURN (652-2876). Fires should not be initiated before 8:00 a.m. and should be completely extinguished before dark.





# **LEAKS**

The City of Statham is continually installing new meters for our customers. These meters have the ability to track your daily usage, and can show the amount of gallons used each day. It can NOT show you where your leak is. The water lines on your private property, you are reasonable for. We can suggest where your leak possibly could be as there are

many types, two are shown here.

This graph shows a continuesues leak that is increasing rapidly. The result was a monthly bill reaching into the \$400.00 range. It was repaired, but that did not correct it fully as the repair did not hold.





This graph to the left shows a running toilet leak, this is a one day high usage and can increase your bill possibly up to \$50.00-\$100.00, more if not caught quickly. A left on water hose will have similar results.

A quick check at your water meter can help you spot leaks. To do so, check to see that everything in your house related to water is off. Remove the lid of your meter and using a flashlight, check to see if the numbers are changing. If so you might have a leak somewhere. If you need assistance in locating your water meter, please call City Hall 770-725-5455 and we will have someone come out and locate it for you.

## **Dates to Remember**

Your water bill is due on the 15th of each month, on the 16th there will be a 10% late fee added. If your bill is not paid in full on or by the 20th, you will be subject to disconnection on the 21st.
